



## **2023 POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS REPORTING**

In 2023, Pentair made no Political Contributions. As defined in Pentair’s Political Contributions Policy, such contributions generally include any corporate spending in the form of a gift, loan, advance or deposit of money to political candidates, political parties, organizations primarily engaged in political activities and ballot initiative organizations.

One U.S.-based trade association or other tax-exempt organizations to which Pentair made a payment of \$50,000 or more in 2023 reported to Pentair that some portion of that payment was used for political activity purposes. The National Association of Manufacturers used a portion (\$18,259) of their funds for lobbying activities. The National Association of Manufacturers is the nation's largest industrial trade association and a leading advocate for a policy agenda that promotes job creation in the manufacturing sector.
